Thank you for your letter and information. I am very glad that the Housing Committee have decided to give the Pavilion another chance by trying to generate local interest in its preservation. If there is any response I should be happy to make a contribution myself.

I appreciate that maintenance is not the only problem involved. The whole complex of Pavilion and Lake must first be accepted psychologically as a valuable environmental amenity. Unfortunately this has not been the case. But, as I tried to point out in my last letter, without a public relations exercise at the start the project was never given a chance.

I am arranging with Mr Philipson, the General Manager of the Peterlee Development Corporation, to go to Peterlee on my next visit to London in January to see the condition of the building myself and I hope I will be given the opportunity of seeing you as well.
